Lot 6 - A three course lunch for four, with wine







<u>Lot 8 – Fishing on The River Exe – an original painting by Gudrun Sibbons</u>

Gudrun Sibbons was a marine and landscape painter in oils. She was born in Germany in 1925 and studied art in Berlin, Breslau and Hamburg. She came to England in 1949 and married portrait painter and fly fisherman William Sibbons.

Gudrun Sibbons started selling her paintings on the Hyde Park railings in London in the 1950's.

Some of her important buyers included David Niven and Errol Flynn which helped boost her fame.

It is believed that the painting for sale is of her husband fishing the Exe.



The picture and frame measure 45cm by 35cm and the visible picture 39.5cm by 29.5cm.

<u>Lot 9 – Snow on beech - A painting by Rory Nugent</u>

Rory studied at the Royal College of Art under Paul Huxley and Michael Heindorff.
